
potential allergies, we ask that you **do not bring a snack containing any nuts or peanut butter**. Please leave the snack area tidy when you leave.

Infant Massage 	0-12 months	Infant Massage promotes nurturing touch and provides many benefits for your infant from birth to one year. Classes are taught by a facilitator trained by the International Association of Infant Massage. Please Register.
Baby & Me	0-15 months	Come and connect with other parents, share stories, listen to occasional guest speakers and learn new songs and rhymes. No registration is required.
Mother Goose 	0-18 months	This very popular 6 week program is designed to foster relationships between parents and their children through songs, stories and rhymes. Please Register.
Drop In	0-6 years	Come visit our EarlyON Child & Family Centre and explore, create, choose and grow through purposeful play in a positive learning environment. Enjoy crafts, fun activities, sensory play and our literacy activities. This is an open and interactive drop-in time, no registration is required!

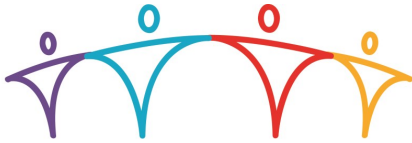
